APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCESS

- The ADN/RN program will now accept applications twice a year for fall and spring admission.
- LVNs are not eligible to apply for the spring 2026 application period.
- Citrus will continue to select all candidates based on the Multi-Criteria for Selection (point system).
- The amount of admitted students varies each application cycle contingent upon the applicant pool.
- All applications are reviewed and processed with decisions released after the deadline passes.
- No priority is given based on when an application is submitted.








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
- The application cannot be saved unless it is officially submitted.
- You may sign in and out of the application, however inputted information will not be saved unless it is submitted.
- Take your time to prepare your documents and information to complete the application.
- The application has a hard deadline therefore it cannot be submitted after the deadline of 3:00pm on October 17th regardless if the application has started before 3:00pm.
- Once an application has been submitted it cannot be changed.

- Official transcripts <u>must</u> be sent directly to the Admissions and Records Office (electronic or mail or inperson) <u>prior</u> to applying.
- It is your responsibility to request the transcripts from the schools you have attended and that they be sent directly to Citrus College's Admissions and Records office.
- Citrus College transcripts do not need to be requested or uploaded.
- It is <u>strongly recommend</u> to include a copy of your transcripts in the online application.
- Transcripts must be from <u>ALL</u> colleges attended.
- Transcripts must be <u>up-to-date</u> (showing current coursework and degrees).
- Advanced Placement (AP) credit posted on transcripts will not be recognized without an official AP score report sent to Admissions and Records.

- Supporting files must be in PDF, Microsoft Word, or JPEG format.
- Other file formats such as GIF, BMP, TIF, screenshot, etc. will not be accepted for the application.
- Each letter/document may be used as verification for only one criterion. Separate documents must be submitted to receive points for each criterion: healthcare experience, second language proficiency, veteran status and life experience.
- Letters must be on letterhead and include an original signature.
- Avoid uploading large files in the application. If necessary, use a compressor tool to reduce the size of a file.
- Do not include photo identification, a social security card or individual tax identification number in the application.
- Do not include a college degree diploma/certificate in the application.
- Do not include an ATI TEAS exam score report in the application.



COMMON MISTAKES TO AVOID

- Not reading application instructions carefully.
- Not submitting official transcripts to Admissions and Records prior to submitting application.
- Transcripts not up-to-date.
- Citrus College email not accessible.
- Missing high school documentation (if applicable).
- Inaccurate reporting of colleges attended.
- Not previewing supplemental documentation prior to uploading them in application.
- Incomplete and/or missing documentation.

Application Instructions

- A. Steps PRIOR to submitting an application
 - Become a Citrus College Student New or former students to Citrus College must complete the <u>online application for admission</u> to receive a Citrus College Student ID number and/or reactivate your account. Continuing students do not need to reapply to Citrus College. Access to the online ADN application will require a <u>Citrus College student email address (office 365)</u> and <u>Citrus login</u>.
 - IMPORTANT: Communication regarding the application will be conducted ONLY through an official Citrus College student email address.
 - If you need further assistance regarding your Citrus College email address and/or login -- please contact <u>TeCServices</u> by phone at (626) 857-4100 or you can also submit a ticket through a <u>support form</u>.
 - 2. Attend an ADN Application Workshop Students are highly encouraged to attend an application workshop. ADN Application workshops and attendance will not be recorded <u>View workshop details and schedules</u>.
 - 3. Meet with a Nursing Counselor Students are highly encouraged to meet with a nursing counselor to discuss eligibility requirements and to get clarification on whether the courses you took outside of Citrus College will be equivalent to ours. <u>Schedule an appointment with a nursing counselor</u>.
 - 4. Submit ALL official college/university transcripts Students MUST submit all official transcripts (regardless of applicability to nursing) to <u>Admissions and Records PRIOR</u> to submitting the ADN application. Official electronic transcripts can be sent to Citrus College's Admissions and Records Office at <u>admissions@citruscollege.edu</u>via <u>parchment.com</u> or other electronic sources. Citrus College transcripts do NOT need to be requested. Official sealed, paper transcripts can be dropped off in person at the Citrus College Admissions and Records Office during regular business hours, or mailed to
