AP 5610 VOTER REGISTRATION

The District will ensure that:

- students, during the class registration process, may apply to register to vote online by submitting an affidavit of voter registration electronically on the website of the Secretary of State;
- voter registration forms are widely available to students at the college;
- the college website provides a link to the Secretary of State website for voter registration information;
- the college distribute campus-wide emails to all students during the first month of each academic semester or quarter with civic and election dates and information, including National Voter Registration Day, the last day to register, early voting dates, and general election dates;
- the college, one month before each statewide election, will distribute an additional email with relevant election information, including online voter registration and voting guides;
- important election reminders are posted on social media, such as early voting dates, election day, and voting by mail;
- the academic calendar includes key election dates, such as National Voter Registration Day, last day to register to vote, and general election dates; and
- the Office of Student Life and Leadership Development will serve as the designated office to promote civic engagement and voter turnout.
