 - a) AP 5031 Instructional Materials Fees – Elizabeth Cook
 - i) Elizabeth Cook goes over the proposed policy and language for AP 5031, which has also been on the agenda and discussed in Academic Senate. Policy requires that we have burden-free materials for our students on the first day of class. It is still a new policy and currently unfunded. Our first step is to create a board policy to indicate that we are working on it; we need to show our intention. The goal is to do a first read in curriculum and bring it back in spring. Please reach out to Elizabeth if you are interested in joining the Instructional Materials Equity Committee.
 - ii) Dana Hester expands that this does not imply that we are provide everything for free for the whole semester, but just to address the inequity that students face at the beginning of the semester. This also applies to supplies, for example, extra goggles when students don't have them for lab. Additionally, we have made a change in financial aid; students will receive a disbursement before the term and that should help them access their materials. For

- funding, lottery could potentially be used to purchase materials that students are able to interact with in the learning environment.
- iii) Catie Besancon also adds that the textbook company she is working with said they have digital access for the first 3 weeks; EC confirms that this meets the spirit of the policy.
 - iv) Amberley Chamberlain asks about providing material for ceramics, DH confirms that we need to be providing that material for the first week.
 - v) Nicholas Hensen spoke about the availability of the texts and sometimes them being on backorder – DH responds with getting more electronic versions for students and those materials.
 - vi) EC also notes that the library is exploring AlmaD for students; it allows us to get a copy and put it on reserve but doesn't check out. The student requests a specific chapter or number of pages instead.
 - vii) DH also notes we need to think about copyright. Fair use typically says that you can use any portion that is 10% or less and it is one time.
 - viii) DH expands on timeline that we can post the draft to show that we are working towards adhering to this policy, but that in terms of the tight turn around time, this probably won't be approved until mid-spring.
