		<p>College provides students with a structured, interdisciplinary foundation in the historical, cultural, political, and social experiences of Chicana/o communities in the United States while ensuring a clear pathway for transfer to the California State University (CSU) system.</p> <p>The ADT includes three core courses aligned with C-ID descriptors: Introduction to Chicana/o Studies (ETHN 116), Chicana/o History: 1848–Present (ETHN 117), and Chicana/Latina Feminism in Contemporary Society (CHS 118), which together provide students with essential theoretical, historical, and intersectional frameworks. These courses examine key topics such as colonization, race, labor, gender, and resistance, and emphasize the lived experiences and contributions of Chicana/o communities.</p> <p>The development of this ADT strengthens Citrus College’s Ethnic Studies offerings, aligns with statewide transfer and general education priorities, and provides students with an efficient pathway to degree completion and transfer. This program directly supports the college’s mission to serve a diverse student population and prepare students for success in a multicultural and socially complex society.</p>
